

Art Workshop: Clay Trinket Bowls

You will learn how to make three different kinds of trinket dishes using air-dry clay. We can provide kits with clay, just call or stop by the West Boca Branch (while supplies last). Kits will be available starting, August 3rd. If you need a kit sent to a different branch, please call no later than a week before the activity.

Art Workshop: Clay Trinket Bowls Part 2

After learning how to make the bowls, drying and painting them, we will meet to share our experiences and discoveries using clay. For this portion of the workshop, you will not need any additional materials. You are welcome to just be an observer and or share your work.

Materials you will need in class:

Air Dry Clay (any brand of air-dry clay)
Small glass/plastic bowls or disposable paper bowls to use as molds.
Rolling pin
Waxed paper or parchment paper
Knife (disposable plastic knife works well)
Small bowl of water
Paper towels
Couple of fresh leaves from trees to make an impression: at least for or 5 inch size.
Aluminum paper
Plastic place mat or any flat nonstick surface to work the clay
Cookie cutters (optional)
Inkpad and stamps or anything else you could use to make an impression.

*Materials you will need to complete your piece once it is dry (after the class):

Sand paper (400 or 600)
Acrylic paint: any colors of your choice and gold cooper or silver.
Gesso
Parchment or wax paper
Brushes
Mod Podge or varnish of choice.

*On our second meeting a week later on Tuesday, August 24th we will show our final pieces and share our experiences working with clay.
