

Weaving

Materials:

Yarn
Cardboard
Scissors

Tape
Paperclip (optional)
Popsicle Stick (optional)

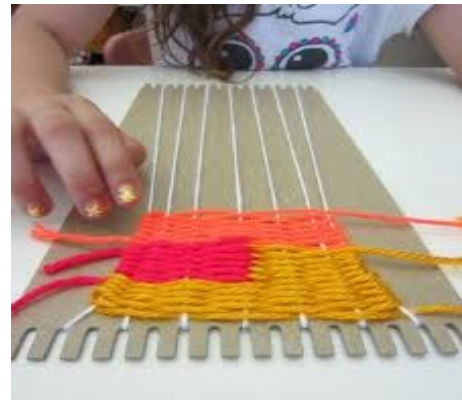
Step 1: Make Cardboard Loom



- Cut a piece of cardboard 2" by 5"
- Ask an adult to cut slits across the top and bottom of the cardboard. These slits are what will hold your threads in place.

Step 2: Warp

- By taping one end of your string to the back, wrap the yarn vertically going to the bottom and back around the top, inserting in the slits. Tape your other end to the cardboard.



Step 3: Weave

- Cut 1-2 feet of yarn and go over and under. Continue back and forth. When you finish a color leave a little tail hanging at the edge. Weave the side pieces back in and cut excess.
- Cut the warp threads of the back. Tie the top ends two at a time.
